Halotherapy Treats Many Skin Conditions And Offers Benefits To the Lungs

Hotels and Resorts are more focused than ever before on therapies and services that address lung health.

Halotherapy, inhalation of fine salt, is quickly becoming a common topic of new spa builds, remodels, and requests by hoteliers to enhance even the smallest of spaces in hotels and resorts. The use of salt for health benefits has been in practice for thousands of years. It is not surprising that many people are now discovering even more uses for salt therapy.

There are some main reasons that halotherapy has taken such a stronghold for allergies, asthma, sinus issues, bronchitis, COPD, and is now being used to support the impact of long-term COVID-19 symptoms.

From an operations standpoint, during a time when staffing may be limited or when considering the cost of commissions and wages, the unit and treatment usually work on their own without a technician. Salt is also a very low-cost product keeping the operational supplies cost down, too. For versatility in equipment and usage, it's a playground for spa-lovers. Options are a dedicated salt room, a multi-use salt room where other modalities such as yoga, massage therapy, meditation, acupuncture, reiki, or IV therapy are performed, or a SALT Booth®.

There are also revenue benefits. Adding this amenity allows an increase in daily use rates while increasing experiential moments for the guests. It also gives guests better value for the money. Resorts can also build it in as an upgrade to a day spa experience or add halotherapy as a stand-alone amenity. TOP 5 REASONS TO ADD A SALT ROOM TO YOUR HOTEL OR RESORT

Hotels and resorts need to prepare for a world where people are more concerned with their respiratory health than ever before - because that time is now.


Strengthening immunity, respiratory wellness, and self-care are on everyone's minds these days. As the latest wave of COVID-19 cases sweeps across the world, people are looking for new ways to treat their respiratory issues.

Do you want to offer more value to your guests and deliver a unique, new amenity that will differentiate your property? How about increasing your revenue without increasing your labor costs?

Then a salt room will be a great addition to your property. Whether you offer spa, wellness, fitness or other services, you can easily add a salt room to complement your existing offerings.

What is Salt Therapy?

Also known as halotherapy, salt therapy involves inhaling salt air that is emitted by halogenerators. This alternative treatment can be offered in the form of salt rooms, sometimes known as salt caves (up to 450 square feet), or SALT Booths® (all that's needed is a 4' x 4' space).



As the fastest growing service at hotel and resort properties, salt therapy can aid in:

- ✓ **Cleansing the Respiratory System**
- ✓ **Improving Lung Function**
- ✓ **Boosting the Immune System**
- ✓ **Enhancing Mental Wellness**

Although this practice is still relatively new to North America, it has been widely used throughout Europe for decades and its origins date back to medieval times.

Adding Salt Therapy Makes Sense for the Travel Industry

The travel industry is experiencing rapid growth as new stand-alone salt facilities are opened, and existing spa businesses and resorts add salt rooms as amenities. In the last 10 years, the number of salt rooms in the US has grown from a dozen in 2012 to thousands today. SALT Chamber alone has worked on over 1,300 salt therapy projects around the world.

This uptick in new salt rooms comes just as the importance of hygiene and respiratory health is at an all-time high.





There are many more reasons to consider incorporating a salt room into your hotel or resort, but we'll focus on these in this article.

#1 MINIMAL INVESTMENT AND ONGOING COSTS EQUAL HIGH ROI

Adding a salt room to your property affects your overhead only minimally. Since this is a touchless service, you won't have to hire additional labor.

Once the salt room is ready to use, all that's needed is salt to add to the halogenerator, which costs very little per session. The power required to run the equipment is also very low.

You'll be able to charge from \$15 to \$60 per session depending on various factors. Given that the cost per session comes out to just a few dollars (including consumables), you can realize profit margins of nearly 300% annually.

Due to its accelerated return on investment, your Salt Therapy Room could pay for itself in as little as six months.


#2 IT'S EASY TO INTEGRATE AND MAINTAIN

Salt therapy can be paired with a variety of other services you may already be offering. Many spas and fitness centers offer combination services, such as a "Salted Massage" or "Salted Yoga", when salt rooms have been added to existing treatment rooms.

You may want to have a dedicated person to greet clients, take reservations, operate the halogenerator, and take care of the occasional cleaning and maintenance. This may not be a necessity, however.

Salt room maintenance is surprisingly simple. Once your Salt Therapy Room is up and running, someone will have to monitor temperature and humidity levels, rake the salt on the floor as needed, and replace the salt. That's it!

Currently, salt therapy doesn't require any special certifications or licensing, for you or your employees, which makes adding this new service even easier.


The salt therapy industry focuses on three main market segments: People with respiratory conditions (approximately 100 million people with asthma, COPD, and allergies)

- ▶ People who fall into the third market segment tend to have more discretionary income and may view salt therapy as an alternative and complementary health care option.

Expanding your facility's spa services by adding salt therapy can not only bring therapeutic benefits to your guests, but it can also help your property generate more revenue as well.

Generate More Revenue For Your Hotel With A Salt Room

Adding salt therapy to your resort is relatively simple. Almost any closed room can be converted into a salt room.

There are some basic requirements though:

- The room needs a fixed ceiling
- There should be adequate ventilation
- Proper placement of the halogenerator
- The fee you can charge per session can range from \$25 to \$55, based on the size of your space and the number of guests you can handle.

As a health benefit, halotherapy is easy to market to guests. It's convenient and affordable for any budget. Clients can spend less than \$50 for a quick session on their lunch break or before a night out. It can also make a great add-on for before or after a massage, or as part of a special package paired with other services.

Costs of Building a Salt Room

As the salt therapy industry continues to grow, more and more people are wanting to know how they can get started or add salt therapy to their property.

And with that interest, people also ask... how much does it cost?

The simple answer to that question is... it depends.

There are various concepts for providing salt therapy at your hotel or resort.

Options are a dedicated salt room, a multi-use salt room where other modalities such as yoga, massage therapy, meditation, acupuncture, reiki, or IV therapy are performed, or a SALT Booth®.

The range to build a salt room is \$4,995-\$18,995+. This greatly depends on the space and technology required. For example, a smaller single room conversion will cost much less than a multiroom salt room.

Salt Room Projects

There are three components to a proper salt room:

1. The Halogenerator (the primary equipment that crushes, grinds, and disperses pure sodium chloride into the room).
2. Room modifications, technical requirements, (HVAC), and environmental concerns.
3. Salt Décor (the largest variable expense) and furnishings.

Salt rooms can range from small rooms (up to 150 sq. ft.) to larger relaxation and multi-purpose rooms (up to 450 sq. ft.).

The size of the room will determine which halogenerator is best, as well as salt décor quantity and other furnishings such as seating, lighting, music, etc.





The Salt Room

The costs for designing and installing a salt room vary depending on the size of the room, décor and lighting packages, furniture, and fixtures. The size of the room will help determine the length of time needed for your return on investment. A smaller room may have 1 to 2 chairs at \$25 each for a 45-minute session, while a larger room may have 6 to 8 chairs for the same price and length.



THE REAL SECRET OF SALT SUCCESS: The Halogenerator

The heart and soul that breathes success to a SALT Booth® or salt room concept starts with the halogenerator. This is the machine that intakes air, grinds and crushes pure grade sodium chloride (salt) into micron-sized salt particles, and then disperses that as dry salt aerosol via a fan through an opening into your SALT Booth® or salt therapy room. Once the halogenerator is installed, all you have to do is put salt into the device and press start.

This is precision equipment that will allow you to provide programmable halotherapy treatment for respiratory and skin conditions.

There is no Salt Therapy without a Halogenerator!

According to the Salt Therapy Association (STA), there are some facilities that claim they offer halotherapy, but they do not have a halogenerator. If there is no halogenerator, there is no halotherapy. They may have salt as a décor feature on the walls and floors, however, the only way dry salt therapy can be provided is with dry salt being dispersed into a salt room or SALT Booth®.

While some claim that heated Himalayan salt can be beneficial in an environment by releasing negative ions and hydroscopically purifying the air, the STA has found this to be false and "mythinformation". Those types of facilities DO NOT provide any benefits of halotherapy.






